

Long-Term Parking Lot Relocation Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

MRY's Long-Term Parking Lot will move to a new location on June 14, 2024. Our parking page includes a <u>graphic to illustrate the parking lot relocation</u>.

Below are some answers to common questions about the changes to our Long-Term lot. If your question is not answered here, please <u>contact us</u> and we will be happy to help.

Q. Why is the Long-Term Parking Lot at MRY being relocated?

A. MRY's Long-Term Parking Lot is moving to make way for constructing new airport safety enhancement projects, including a relocated commercial aircraft parking apron and replacement passenger terminal.

The Long-Term Parking Lot relocation is the first change travelers will experience as part of the MRY Safety Enhancement Program (SEP).

Q. Where is the entrance to the relocated Long-Term lot?

A. The entrance to the relocated Long-Term lot is the first right on Olmsted Road, the airport's primary access roadway.

Signage along Olmsted Road will guide travelers to the relocated lot.

Q. Is the relocated Long-Term lot a farther distance from the terminal building?

A. On average, travelers will walk the same number of footsteps along a clearly marked pathway between the relocated parking lot and the terminal building, about a 3-5 minute walk. The parking lot is illuminated using solar powered lighting.

Airport staff are committed to keeping MRY convenient, easy to use, and hassle-free.

Q. Is there any change to the Long-Term lot rates and the number of spaces?

A. The relocated lot will offer the same <u>parking rates</u> and the same number of parking spaces, and is accessible 24/7/365.

Customers can pay with a credit or debit card while in their vehicle at the lot exit. Cashpaying customers can request a parking attendant respond by pushing a button at the lot exit.

Q. Are the short-term parking lots being relocated also?

A. No changes are being made to the short-term parking lots at MRY, and the entrance and exits to these lots will remain the same.

Q. Where can I find accessible parking with I flyout MRY?

A. MRY's accessible parking spaces are located in the Short-Term Parking Lot, and are available first-come, first-served.

<u>Long-Term rates</u> for travelers with a current DMV-issued disabled-person placard or license plates are offered.

Q. Where can I park and charge my electric vehicle when I fly out of MRY?

A. MRY's electric vehicle parking is located in the Short-Term Parking Lot.

Four (4) ChargePoint Direct-Current Fast Chargers are available first-come, first-served, and are accessible 24/7/365.

The charging cost is a \$5.00 flat fee.

Parking rates for the Short-Term lot apply.
